

Providence Christian School **Kindergarten Curriculum**

Language and Creative Writing: A Beka

The student will be able to compose and recognize a complete sentence, identify and create opposites and rhymes, compose and read the four kinds of sentences, identify and practice pausing at a comma, place thoughts and sentences in the correct order, understand simple poetry concepts, and create stories.

Phonics and Reading: A Beka and numerous “whole” books

The student will be able to pronounce and recognize special sounds with mastery, state and apply the rules of reading using consonants and vowel sounds, and read blend ladders and small books as he/she learns new sounds.

Spelling and Handwriting: A Beka

The student will be able to spell words correctly according to the phonics rules and special sounds learned, recall sight words correctly, and exhibit proper formations in handwriting.

Mathematics: Saxon Math

The student will be able to recognize and write numbers 1-100, identify and count coins, tell time to the hour and the quarter hour, count by 2's, 5's and 10's to 100, state ordinal numbers, identify half of an object, master addition and subtraction facts (0 and 1), recognize and measure by inches, recognize and continue patterns, identify and draw shapes, recall seasons, state days of the week and months of the year on the calendar.

Social Studies: A Beka and unit studies

- **All About Me**

The student will learn about community helpers, health, safety, teachers, travel, food, and service.

- **Countries Around the World**

The student will learn about Israel, Italy, Netherlands, Germany, Russia, England, France, Canada, Peru, China, Japan, Mexico, Kenya, and Australia.

Science: Christian Schools International

The year's studies will focus on investigating health, living things, materials, transportation, and God's non-living world.

Bible: CSI Bible

The student will be able to recognize God as the Creator of the world, understand that the Ten Commandments are God's rules by which His people are to live, learn through the stories of Jesus' life on earth, identify the major characters and events surrounding the birth of Jesus, learn that Jesus died for people's sin and rose from the dead, and memorize Scripture.
